VSSD has observed while working at ground that most of the disabled person in the society were not able to avail even the basic facilities offered by the Central /state government. Therefore, VSSD has established under the Society Act and became a social organization in December 1994 as a non-profits organization to support to fulfill the needs of individuals with disabilities in the society. This support is in terms of Basic Education, Skill Training, Vocational Training and Placement etc.</p> <p>VSSD has successfully implemented its projects and goal orientated Programs of promotion for help to the disabled persons of different organizations whether private or government and corporate sector and it has successfully conducted Vocation Trainings so that maximum number of students must be sent to schools and colleges through scholarships for their education.</p> <p>VSSD ensures providing opportunities to every PwDs and underprivileged youth irrespective of their caste, creed, gender, religion, status etc. provided with quality Vocational Training and proper guidance in an appropriate environment for their overall growth. Recently, our Vocational Training Centres are reaching towards their respective targets of providing committed services to PwDs and we do have the aim to empower them socially and economically through gainful employment. For that we are still making our efforts to build skills through Vocational Trainings to students of the rural as well as the slum areas of Delhi and NCR.</p>

20	Current Running Projects	<p>Skill development training:-</p> <p>Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi (VSSD) has its core activity to provide the Vocational Trainings to youths for developing the commercial skills alongwith the traditional education to get gainful employment/self-employment, which plays a significant and remedial role in balancing the socio-economic conditions of the individuals or their families. VSSD ensures that every person with disability and underprivileged Youth irrespective of their caste, creed, gender, religion and category must be provided with quality Vocational Training and proper guidance in an appropriate environment for their overall growth and empowerment.</p> <p>Currently, the different Vocational Training Centers of VSSD are touching the number of approx 12357 people those have taken the quality training. These trainings are evaluated through examination, duly conducted by their respective instructor and support for providing job in such programs for which purposefully our organization enrolls students covering most of the rural and slum Areas of Delhi NCR.</p>

		<p>SELF-EMPLOYMENT (APNA ROZGAR YOJNA):- Through Viklang Margdarshan Kendra, regularly guidance for self-employment (Self-Employment Scheme) is being offered to Persons with Disabilities, who belongs to Economically Weaker Sections. Also under Apna Rozgar Yojna (ARY) program is for needy PwDs and individual youths, those who are illiterate, unskilled and jobless are taken care. As of now 2450 beneficiaries are assisted through ARY program and these beneficiaries are earning between RS. 100 to 300 per day.</p> <p>Further, The ARY is extended its programs to support more heads as “Dhaba”, “Pan stall”, “cobbler (mochi)”, “General store”, “Tailor”, “vegetable selling”, “Mehandi stalls” etc. (not in cash).</p> <p>Self- Employment helps in defining an individual’s place in the community especially to help the disabled citizens, live a normal, dignified and independent life.</p>
		<p>VIKAS - A day care scheme of National Trust :-</p> <p>Vikas Day Care for special children of the age above 10 years with AUTISM, CP, MR, Intellectual Disability and multiple disabilities. In our day care centers, we have appointed trained staff and special educators those who take care of special need of every individual child inclusive their education.</p>
		<p>DISHA - An Early Intervention Scheme of National Trust :- Disha is a scheme for early intervention to the children of age 0-10 years with AUTISM, CP, MR, Intellectual Disability and multiple disabilities where there are dedicated services to special children through our committed and trained staff day to day activities learning to children.</p>
		<p>DISTRIBUTION of AIDS/APPLIANCES:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To arrange full rehabilitation management of Disabled like:- surgery/mobility Aids/Appliances like Caliper, Crutches, Tricycle, Wheel Chair, stick and other appliance below the age of 18 years is organized a camp at Delhi and nearby area. • Arrange OPD for people with disability (PwD). Arrange physiotherapy for physically Disabled every evening. Approx 2,686 people were benefited till the date.

		<p>LOAN FOR SELF EMPLOYMENT:- Loan with no interest is provided to set up a small business to individual and Self Help Groups(SHG) with disabilities to unemployed youths, so as to provide them a change to be self sustainable.</p>
		<p>EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helps in getting admission in the Govt. Schools & provide Stationary to the physically handicapped. • Guidelines to the students for scholarships from U.T. & State Govt. NGO/Public • Educational, Social Counselling, Guidance for the bright future. • An Integrated group of abled children with the Physically Challenged study together in equal number from Nursery to class VIII. The institution is affiliated to National Institute of Open School for class X, XII and provides Vocational Courses Counselling Individual and Group Therapy. Regular Sessions with the parents of Children. • Registration with NIOS for Xth and XIIth Classes. Organization provided facilities for creche for local community children.
		<p>PUBLIC LIBRARY:- VSSD has set up its own Public library for the local persons with disabilities and youths of the society. It is an attempt for children and adults to gain knowledge and information easily. It's a good opportunity for lifelong learning. It helps children and youths to develop imagination and creativity, and give adults the opportunity to learn about their cultural heritage, about the arts, science and technology.</p>
		<p>NIRMAYA A Health Insurance Scheme of National Trust :- This scheme is for the welfare of persons with Autism, Cerebral palsy, Mental Retardation, intellectual Disability and Multiple Disabilities. Enrolled beneficiaries are facilitated with Niramaya Policy for their treatment through National trust. Being registered organization of National Trust, our staff is authorized for new / renewal cases.</p>
		<p>SWAVLAMBAN Health Policy for Persons with Disabilities:- It's prestigious Health insurance Scheme for Persons with Disabilities launched by MSJE, Govt of India through New India Assurance Company limited, to Provide affordable Health Insurance to persons with Blindness, Low Vision, leprosy-Cured, Hearing Impairment, Loco-Motor disability, Mental-Retardation and mental illness. We guide PwDs to get themselves enrolled in Swavlamban Scheme.</p>
		<p>Self Help Group:- Self-Help Group (SHG) is a small voluntary association of poor people, preferably from the same socio-economic background. They come together for solving their common problems through self-help and mutual help. The SHG promotes small savings among its members. We help to make SHG of beneficiaries.</p>
		<p>Legal Guidance/Local Level Committee(LLC) :- LLC is a district level committee to provide guardianship for persons with autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and multiple disabilities. VSSD is a LLC for North-west district.</p>
