Report on State Level Workshop for Implementation of Schemes

1. Title of the Workshop:

State Level Workshop on Effective Implementation of Government Schemes

3. Organized by:

4. Objective of the Workshop:

The primary objective of the workshop was to enhance the understanding and capacity of state-level officials and stake holders in the effective implementation of central and state-sponsored schemes. The workshop aimed to address challenges, share best practices, and create a common platform for dialogue and coordination.

6. Inaugural Session:

The workshop began with a welcome address by Mr. Kapil Kumar Aggarwal, Founder and CEO for Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi, followed by inaugural remarks from Ms. Anjali Sehrawat (IAS), Director, Department of Social Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, New Delhi. The importance of timely and efficient delivery of welfare schemes was emphasized, along with the need for innovation and accountability.

7. Technical Sessions:

The workshop included multiple technical sessions and presentations such as:

- **Session1:** Overview of Key Government Schemes
Presented by: Dept. of Social Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- **Session2:** Challenges in Ground-Level Implementation
Panel Discussion with National Advisor, The National Trust, MSJE, Govt. of India.
- **Session3:** Best Practices and key interventions required to ward development. Presentations by selected speakers and General discussion among the NGO representatives.
- **The National Trust, Govt. of India:** Presented on various schemes and initiatives under the National Trust Act for persons with disabilities, including awareness, early intervention, and community-based programs.
- **Department of Social Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi:** Shared state-level efforts and services extended to PwDs, such as financial assistance, UDID enrollment, and rehabilitation support. The department also highlighted challenges in ground-level implementation.
- **Institute of Human Behavior and Allied Sciences (IHBAS), Govt. of NCT of Delhi:** Focused on mental health services and rehabilitation programs for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

- **Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (ALIMCO), MSJE, Govt. of India:** Demonstrated the availability of assistive devices and aids, as well as their efforts to expand outreach in rural and underserved areas.
- **Railway DRM Office, Indian Railways, Govt. of India:** Spoke about initiatives for accessible travel and reservation benefits for PwDs, as well as plans to improve station infrastructure.
- **Vocational Rehabilitation Centre, Ministry of Labour, Govt. of India:** Presented on skill training programs, employment facilitation, and vocational assessments conducted to enable self-reliance among PwDs.
- **Delhi State Legal Services Authority (DSLISA), Law Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi:** Highlighted the legal rights of persons with disabilities and available free legal aid services. Awareness drives and counseling efforts were also discussed.
- **National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC), Govt. of India:** Provided insights into financial schemes, concessional loans, and entrepreneurship support available for PwDs.

8. Group Discussions & Recommendations:

Participants were divided into four groups to discuss them at i care as such as UDID/Disability Certificate, Sports/Inclusive education, Awareness/Accessibility and Skill Development/Employment. The key recommendations included:

- **Strengthen Inter-Departmental Coordination:** Improve collaboration among departments within hospitals to streamline the issuance of UDID/Disability Certificates.
- **Capacity Building:** Organize regular training and capacity-building sessions for implementing officers to expedite action on pending applications, including those requiring Local Government (LG) approval through Local Level Committees (LLC).
- **Ensure Reservation Compliance:** Implement strict monitoring mechanisms to ensure 4% reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in open recruitment processes.

- **Grassroots Awareness:** Launch extensive awareness campaigns at the grassroots level to educate the general public about government schemes for PwDs.
- **Accessibility Drives:** Conduct regular accessibility audits and drives in public spaces to promote inclusive infrastructure.
- **Job Portal for PwDs:** Establish a dedicated state-level job portal exclusively for Divyangjan.
- **Accessible Infrastructure:** Promote awareness and implementation of accessibility standards in public buildings, including the construction of ramps, accessible toilets, and other inclusive facilities.
- **Inclusive Education:** Address the difficulties faced by children with disabilities in gaining admission to mainstream schools and ensure inclusive educational opportunities.
- **Reservation in All Sectors:** Ensure reservation for PwDs in both government and private sectors.
- **Skill Development Centers:** Set up more district-level skill training centers tailored to the needs of PwDs.
- **Concessional Loans:** Provide loans at reduced interest rates for persons with disabilities to support entrepreneurship and self-reliance.
- **Insurance Coverage:** Design insurance schemes with coverage amounts up to ₹5 lakhs for PwDs.
- **Ayushman Bharat Inclusion:** Ensure that all types of disabilities are comprehensively covered under the Ayushman Bharat Scheme.

9. Valedictory Session:

The valedictory session was chaired by Mr. Bunty Solanki, General Secretary Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi, who acknowledged the active participation of all attendees and encouraged continued collaboration for improved governance.

10. Outcome of the Workshop:

The workshop served as an informative session, detailing various government schemes tailored for organizations dedicated to the welfare of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs). This initiative provided a crucial platform for numerous organizations and government departments to converge, fostering the exchange of feedback and valuable suggestions. This collaborative effort, spearheaded by NGOs, represents a unique opportunity to unite both governmental and non-governmental entities, facilitating a more cohesive approach to support and enhance lives of PwDs.

Follow-Up Actions:

- Preparation of a detailed action report and its circulation to all departments concern for citizen with disabilities.
- Setting up a monitoring committee to track progress
- SNAC to coordinate district-level workshops by December 2025

11. Conclusion:

The workshop concluded on a positive note with a strong collective commitment to enhance service delivery and ensure that the benefits of government schemes effectively reach the intended beneficiaries, particularly persons with disabilities. The event successfully brought together key stakeholders from government departments, NGOs, and the private sector, fostering a platform for meaningful dialogue and knowledge-sharing. It not only highlighted the challenges in scheme implementation but also reinforced the importance of multi-sectoral collaboration to drive inclusive and transparent development.
