Believing in these ideals and striving toward a bright career in social work, National Youth Awardee Sh. Kapil Kumar Aggarwal has emerged as a renowned entrepreneur and social activist. A self-made individual with a versatile personality, he has dedicated his life to various social causes.

He is the Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi (VSSD), a non-governmental organization committed to the welfare and education of persons with disabilities (PwDs) and underprivileged sections of society. Recognizing that PwDs are among the most marginalized groups—often unable to access government facilities due to lack of awareness and illiteracy—he took the initiative to establish this organization in December 1994.

From an early age, he was deeply moved by the struggles faced by PwDs, who were deprived of equal opportunities and social inclusion. Choosing purpose over personal gain, he left behind a lucrative career to dedicate himself entirely to this cause. His mission has been to bring transformative change in the lives of disabled individuals by ensuring equal opportunities and enabling their full participation in society.

For his unwavering commitment and humanitarian efforts, he has been honored with numerous awards, including the prestigious National Youth Award in 2011.

CHILDHOOD & EARLY LIFE

- Shri Kapil Kumar Aggarwal was born on 15th June, 1979 in Alwar, Rajasthan. Since childhood, he was a very compassionate individual. He noticed that PwDs are one of the most marginalized parts of our society.
- Disturbed by the plight of the PwDs, he decided to do something extraordinary about it and now he is on the path of success.
- He have been working for inclusion and development of Persons with Disabilities through various workshops, events, activities, actions and trainings which includes Skill Development Training of an individual, Painting, Exhibition, Changing mindsets Program, Theatre Workshops and other.

AIM OF SOCIAL LIFE

Since the age of 12, he has been actively engaged in the welfare and education of persons with disabilities. Early in life, he resolved that his purpose would be dedicated to the education and rehabilitation of physically challenged individuals. With a deep commitment to social development, he has consistently worked toward creating an inclusive environment that ensures equal opportunities for persons with disabilities, enabling their full participation in the mainstream of society and access to the same rights and entitlements as others.

Reflecting on the journey since 1994, through Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi (VSSD), he has expanded outreach to new geographies, empowered numerous youth with disabilities through skill development initiatives, promoted inclusive education, and facilitated employment opportunities. His efforts have not only enhanced livelihoods but have also instilled confidence and a renewed sense of purpose among beneficiaries, encouraging them to embrace life with optimism.

With a vision of a society grounded in equal opportunities, he recognizes that addressing the needs of persons with disabilities alone is not sufficient. Sustainable change requires transformation at multiple levels. To achieve this, VSSD operates through a three-pronged approach: ensuring access to essential services, building robust support systems, and creating a competitive edge for individuals with disabilities to thrive independently.

INVOLVED IN SERVICES TO SOCIETY

Since 1994, many projects are undertaken as

- **SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING:** - that focusing on providing the Vocational Training to Youth for developing the commercial skills along with the traditional education to get lucrative Employment/Self-Employment, which plays a significant and remedial role in balancing the socio-economic conditions of the individuals or their families.

He ensures that every Persons with Disabilities and underprivileged Youth irrespective of their caste, creed, gender, religion and category must be provided with quality Vocational Training and proper guidance in an appropriate environment for their overall growth and empowerment.

- **Viklang Margdarshan Kendra (VMK):-** Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) are the most marginalized part of our society due to lack of knowledge and proper awareness into them. Approximately 80% of them have no access to any services. In the absence of required facilities many such families are forced to abandon their children on streets. But, it is assumed that an aware and sensitized society can reduce the struggles of such people and their families. Moreover, families need to know the rights of their child. There are several Govt. schemes also there under which based on his/her disability. To address such issues and offer solutions, **Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi** has set up its own Counseling Centre called **“Viklang Margdarshan Kendra” in year 1994**. Since then, this Kendra has served thousand of persons with disabilities and provided counseling to their respective families also. It is a guidance centre that provides information about all the facilities available to Persons with Disabilities without any botheration.

- **EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE:-**

Help them to get admission in the Govt. Schools & provide Stationery to Children and Youth having Disabilities and work as per the guidelines for the students for scholarships from U.T. & State Govt. NGO/Public for Education and provide Social Counseling and Guidance for their bright future.

- **NIRMAYA POLICY:-**

This scheme is for the welfare of persons with Autism, Cerebral palsy, Mental Retardation (Intellectual Disability) and Multiple Disabilities. Children having Disabilities are facilitating re-imbursement under Niramaya Policy for their treatment through National Trust.

- **Legal Guardianship (LLC):-**

Local Level Committee is a district level committee to provide guardianship for Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation (Intellectual Disability) and Multiple Disabilities under the Chairmanship of District Collector/ District Magistrate.

- **Employment: -**

Registration/ Coordinate with various Government Agencies and Non- Profit Organizations for providing Employment Opportunities to our beneficiaries and refer them in reputed organization/ company.

- **CBR services:-**

- Organization is facilitating the Disability Certificates, Railway concession certificates through State designated Hospital.
- Organization is facilitating the SDM I-Card from area SDM Office in Delhi.
- Organization is facilitating DTC Bus Pass from area DTC Bus Pass Section.
- Disseminate information about Govt. schemes Policies/Benefits/Concessions for Differently Abled Persons and Marginalized segments.

- **Self Help Group:-**

Self-Help Group (SHG) is a small voluntary association of poor people, preferably from the same socio-economic background. They work together for solving their common problems through self-help and mutual help. The SHG promotes small savings among its members. We help to make SHG of beneficiaries and maintain mutual relationships.

- **LOAN FOR SELF EMPLOYMENT:-**

Loan with no interest is providing to set up a business based on their own interest or to extend their business which they already running. It is basically for providing assets in relation to the business startup.

- **MATRIMONIAL SERVICE:-**

Viklang Sahara Samiti Delhi committed to serve their services to people who can or cannot afford their marriage, or cannot find their life partner, because of their physical disabilities (Divyangjan), for all those candidates we are supporting them with open heart and try to give them greatest gift ever “A loving and caring life partner” to share their happiness & divide their sorrow. We understand their preferences and committed to find their compatible match. We aim to provide a platform where disabled person can come together to find a suitable life partner. VSSD started online form i.e. Marriage registration for PwDs for all over India that purpose to settle their life with their compatible partners and after the registered applications of PwD candidates the Mega Sammelan will be organize to find a suitable life partner.
